If you chose sick/ill, please list how you are related. Requests must come from immediate family members to be mentioned aloud or from the ill person, otherwise the name will be listed for silent prayers
If you chose special occasion, please list the occasion here so we know.

Reminder:

You are allowed to choose a maximum of **two Sunday Masses** and four weekday Masses and **no more than six Masses** for any one intention/individual in a 12-month period. Additional Mass requests may be accepted, if approved by the pastor, but may be distributed to other diocesan priests in small parishes in the diocese who receive few requests with the consent of the donor.

Mass intentions are **not** scheduled for Good Friday, All Souls Day, or a scheduled day on which daily Mass will normally not be celebrated (e.g., Friday after Thanksgiving).

Sunday's Mass at 5:30pm will be Pro Populo (For the People) and no other requests can be taken for this Mass time. Requests will be honored on a first-come-first-serve basis in the order in which the request is received at the Parish Office. If the requested date is unavailable, we will list your request at the next available day/time as requested.
