On the same date, Fr. James Singarayar, HNG will become our new parochial vicar. Allow me to tell you a little about him. Fr. James is the youngest of three children born into his family in India. He attended Catholic schools there as a child and youth. He holds a B.A. in Arts, an M.A. in Christian Studies, and an M.Phil. in Western Philosophy and was ordained in 2009. He is a member of the Heralds of Good News religious order. He served as a professor of philosophy and dean of philosophy at St. John's College in India for four years and then as parochial vicar and pastor between 2016-2023 in the Archdiocese of Mobile, AL and Baton Rouge, LA.

As we draw closer to the time of this transition, more information will become available, especially in terms of helping Fr. Alex and Fr. James in their physical transitions.
