



WHY ARE WE STILL PRAYING THE SYNOD PRAYER?

Pope Francis has asked churches throughout the world to pray for the success of the upcoming Synod that will take place in Rome in October 2023 and 2024. Why? Because this Synod, in comparison to the other 25 that have taken place since Vatican II ended in 1965, will be dramatically different and has the potential to move the Church forward in a very important way.

Some have said this Synod will be Pope Francis' most important initiative and legacy as the leader of the Catholic Church. But what is a synod and why is this one so important?

A synod is a gathering of representatives of the Catholic Church throughout the world who meet, discuss, and make recommendations on a topic of importance identified by the Pope. Bishops were the only voting members of all previous synods. This year's Synod will include 70 lay people, half of whom will be women, who will have full voting rights, an historic first in the Church. The Pope's thinking is tied to Vatican II where co-responsibility between the laity (baptismal priests) and clergy (ministerial priests) was envisioned as a normative way of discerning the direction of the Holy Spirit in the Church. In Francis' view, the synod operates on the principle that laity and clergy together both listen and learn. For a church known for its hierarchical structure where traditionally the clergy speak and teach and the laity listen and learn, an approach to being Church that is collaborative and dialogical has the potential to renew and invigorate it, something sorely needed as we enter the 21st century.

Someone has correctly said this Synod will not be a panacea to solve all our problems but will hopefully offer us a blueprint for how we can move the Church forward. Those who are issue driven will likely be disappointed in the Synod because its goal is not to resolve specific issues. Its goal is to embrace listening, collegiality, and co-responsibility as a way of life for the Church by practicing listening, collegiality, and co-responsibility. It is to "build and strengthen our communion with Christ and each other by listening patiently, by going to the margins to let the poor teach us, creating ongoing formation in both synodality and discernment, and engaging charitably the tensions that exist within the Church." I pray I live long enough to see the fruit of this Synod. This is one reason I gladly pray the Synod Prayer each week, asking the Holy Spirit to guide us forward.
