Return of Communion from the Cup:

Bishop Luís recently sent a letter to all pastors that he was granting them permission to restore the practice of offering the Holy Eucharist under Both Species at their discretion. More and more parishes and dioceses throughout the United States are resuming this practice.

After conversation with Jim Wahl, our director of liturgy and music, and Kathy Sales, our director of pastoral ministries, I have asked Jim to begin a process by which Communion from the Cup can be reintroduced to our parish. There will be several preparatory steps to this process. The main ones are: 1) ascertain if we have enough Eucharistic Ministers to cover the restoration of the cup and, if we don't have enough, to recruit and commission more ministers; 2) retool our Eucharistic Ministers since it has been over three and a half years since we last offered Holy Communion this way; and 3) catechize the community about the importance, value, and safety of partaking of the Blood of Christ from a common cup.

We are looking at September 30-October 1 as our inaugural weekend to offer the cup, the weekend we will celebrate the Feast of St. Francis. Those who go to daily Mass will be able to receive Communion under both kinds beginning Monday, October 2. Further study will be required to determine if and when to restore the Communion cup to the weekly TFS Masses. Until further notice, school Masses will not include the reception of Holy Communion from the cup.

I am happy to see this practice restored to our liturgical celebrations. It will remain optional for everyone and may provide an alternative for those who are unable to receive the Body of Christ because of food allergies associated with an ingredient in the bread.


