# August 13, 2023 Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



Let the Blessings Begin! I want to thank all of you who have supported the Franciscan Garden art project so far. Because of your generosity, we have been able to acquire the two largest pieces of art and commission the first plague. The bronze sitting St. Francis statue and the St. Clare mosaic have arrived and site work is being completed this week for their placement in the garden. Through a generous gift from Fr. Mark Reamer, OFM, vice

president for mission at Siena College in New York and a former pastor of St. Francis, the St. Bernardine of Siena plague has been commissioned. The plague will be placed in the garden upon completion.

To celebrate the arrival of the two large works of art, I invite you to join me in the Franciscan Garden after the 9:00am Mass on Sunday, August 20, for the formal blessing of the St. Francis statue and the St. Clare mosaic. It is appropriate that St. Clare's image will be attached to the outside wall of Clare Hall. It will be located between the two pergolas. The sitting St. Francis bronze statue will be placed outside the doors of Elizabeth Hall, the location of our pre-school. The statue will be "user friendly," meaning that those who would like to sit next to St. Francis may do so. I'm imagining our vounger members will especially enjoy being so close to our patron saint and perhaps getting a photo with him as well.

The fundraiser will continue until we have commissioned the remaining plaques honoring the Franciscans whose names adorn our building and rooms but we have art that is ready to be placed, hence the first round of blessings for them. I invite you to make a gift in support of this project if you haven't done so already. This will be a great way to educate our parishioners and others about the important legacy these Franciscan men and women have left us by the witness of their lives and serve as another concrete way we are endeavoring to maintain our Franciscan identity.
