Third Anniversary: On September 1, I celebrated my third anniversary as your pastor. The life of our community continues its journey back to normal and we've seen some wonderful things happen in the past 12 months. Highlights include the dedication of an addition to our columbarium, the near completion of our Franciscan Garden art project, and the retirement of our

remaining mortgage making us debt free. As of July 1, we have grown to 5,342 households (15,039 parishioners) and celebrated 186 baptisms and 182 first communions. On September 9, Bishop Luís will confirm 268 teens and adults. We've had over 70 adults and children of catechetical age participate in our RCIA process in the previous 12 months. Our schools are near capacity. I can easily say I'm never bored!

Offertory Appeal: Each year we take a couple of weekends to bring you up to date on how we stewarded your financial support to operate the parish and where we hope to grow financially in the coming year with your help to continue the mission of our faith community. On the weekend of September 9-10, I will address the community at all Masses to express my gratitude for your generosity and invite you to partner with us in this new fiscal year as we continue our mission to grow in holiness, offer hope to those who hunger for human dignity, and extend hospitality to all. On the weekend of September 16-17, Steve Vebber, chair of our parish's Finance Council, will provide you with a summary of how we used our financial resources in the fiscal year that ended June 30 and what we hope to accomplish in the current fiscal year.

Four-Part Series on the Mass: There have been many requests for an opportunity to learn more about the Mass, the center of our spiritual lives as a community of faith and the wellspring from which our service and ministries flow. Over four weekends, I will speak at all Masses going through it part by part. The series will run as follows:
