# September 10, 2023 Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time



A Series of Homilies on the Mass: At various times over the past year, parishioners and staff have commented on how they'd like to learn more about the Mass and if I would be willing to offer some presentations on it. In response to these inquiries and requests, I will embark on a four-part series on the Mass at every weekend Mass beginning the weekend of September

23-24. Each week in the series, I will offer a brief presentation on a specific part of the Mass and will present the homily just before we start that part of the Mass so that what I present will be fresh in your minds as we actually celebrate that part of the Mass. As a result, the homilies these four weekends will not occur in their traditional place after the Gospel. (No, there will not be an additional homily after the Gospel nor will there be any other additional rituals/sacraments during these four weekends!).

There will be a handout given to you as you come to Mass on each of these weekends so you have something to help you follow the presentation and perhaps keep as reference for ongoing conversation, especially for those who have children. Here is the schedule and where the homily will occur:

#### September 23-24: Introductory Rites of the Mass

-Presentation: Immediately after we make the opening Sign of the Cross September 30-October 1: Liturgy of the Word -Presentation: Immediately before the first Scripture reading October 7-8: No presentation as I will be away this weekend October 14-15: Preparation of the Altar and Eucharistic Prayer

-Presentation: Immediately after the Prayers of the Faithful

October 21-22: Communion Rite and Concluding Rites -Presentation: Immediately before the Lord's Prayer

The Mass is the center of our life as Catholics. Increasingly, Catholics seem to be unaware of this. It is the wellspring of our spiritual lives. Spirituality is defined as the way we experience our relationship with God (i.e., prayer) and live out that relationship in daily life (i.e., life). All spiritualities are meant to cultivate an interior relationship between God and a person/group (prayer) and an <u>external</u> relationship between a person/group and others that is the fruit of the interior relationship (life).

If you are away from the parish on one of these weekends, you will be able to view the archived homily on our website. I look forward to offering these presentations.
