FINANCE COUNCIL APPEAL: I have worked with many Finance Councils over my 43 years as a priest, but the one at St. Francis is by far the best. I have been consistently impressed by the expertise the members bring to the table, their dedication to our wonderful community, and their passion to keep us on solid ground in terms of our financial and material

resources. Not too long ago, I discovered that we needed some type of mechanism to allow members to gracefully conclude their service and new members to share their expertise with us. What brought this into clear relief was the discovery that some of our members have been on this council for 30+ years (their place in heaven is assured!!).

In light of this, we have now established a structure for members to serve for terms and have a rotation schedule in place that allow current members to conclude their service and new members to join the council. We are beginning to implement this structure and will need new members in the near future.

If this is something you might be interested in, allow me to lay out some qualifications we would be looking for in consideration of an appointment to the council. First, we are looking for someone who is active in the life of the parish, someone who worships with us regularly, financially supports us, and volunteers in some part of our community's life. We would also look for someone who has specific professional experience in financial, facility, or organizational management. Does this prospective member have a passion for our community and its values and priorities and desires to see these continue thriving? Lastly, we would look for someone who is willing to serve on an oversight committee that is connected to the church, one of the schools, the columbarium, maintenance, endowments, or justice and peace.

The council meets 6-7 times a year for approximately 2 hours per meeting and a term is for four years, renewable upon agreement by the pastor and councilor for an additional term.
