

#### A NEW STRATEGIC PARISH PASTORAL PLAN:

One of the signs of a healthy parish community is having an established vision and actual benchmarks to validate the vision. A pastoral plan lays out the vision and the subsequent benchmarks. We've had a couple of them over the life of the parish. It was discerned last year by

the Pastoral Council that we were ready to undertake an update. This process began officially last April with preliminary meetings to discuss hopes and dreams, process, and timelines. A committee consisting of representatives of the parish was selected and has been meeting regularly since July 2023. The members are Jacob House, Eyram Klu, John Price, Kate Shiring, Mae Villanueva, Melissa Yeazel, Micah Slusser, Peter Russo, Mike McGrail, and Shawn Tenace with Kathy Sales and Diogenes Ruiz serving as ex-officio staff members. I'm also on the committee. Our goal is to have a five-year plan in place by June 30, 2024.

Using the principles of synodality, we processed a lot of data available to us from previous planning efforts as well as input from our parish Synod listening sessions in our initial meetings. After prayer consideration, we drafted a Purpose, a Vision, and a Mission statement (see below) as well as a set of Priorities (see next week's Comments). We are currently wrapping up work on a realistic, actionable, and most importantly, Spirit-inspired set of Goals and Objectives. We plan to share these with the Pastoral Council, Finance Council, Youth Advisory Council, both School Councils, staff, and the rest of the community by mid-March, at which time we will shift to detailed implementation planning. The following words were prayerfully discerned by the entire committee. It is my pleasure to share them with you now.

**Purpose Statement:** We exist as a faith community to discover and celebrate Jesus Christ so we may joyfully serve Him by authentically encountering, sharing, and building the reign of God.

Vision Statement: Our vision is to awaken in every heart the desire for the Lord and the care of all God's creation in community formed by the Word of God, sacraments, and one another.

**Mission Statement:** Engage with a faith community that supports you. Encounter the God who loves you. Serve and transform the world that needs you.
