 - c. Finance Council update
 - i. Budget for 2023-2024 fiscal year has been approved
 - ii. Priorities in budget are: focus on J&P initiatives, expanding youth and young adult formation, paying employees a competitive wage, funding so all can afford a Catholic education, and support for the aging campus
 - iii. School budgets are based on TFS enrollment of 658 and Preschool enrollment of 160
 - iv. The accepted TFS budget brings teacher salaries to 97% of the published state scale, two years earlier than planned
 - v. Paying off Siena loan allows bigger contributions to the maintenance reserve fund
 - vi. YTD fiscal is ahead of budget in all categories
 - vii. Offertory is 5% ahead of last year
 - viii. Columbarium sales are on fire
 - ix. Request was made to have earlier and more collaboration on the budget between the Finance Council and the Pastoral Council
 - d. Bulletin and communication plan
 - i. New bulletin is evolving
 - ii. New bulletin has links to Realm, St. Francis Serves, social media
 - iii. Survey data on the bulletin indicates more people are reading more of the existing content
 - 1. Most important content: Pastor comments, upcoming events, editorial comments
 - iv. Data also shows the social media platform users are growing very well
 - v. New format drives active engagement in parish information, not passive
 - vi. Continuing focus on evangelization
 - vii. Looking for more video content, images
 - viii. Discussing a youth Facebook takeover where youth control all content for a day

- ix. Request was made to add links on the parish website to the parish history documents, the Councils and members, and the school boards and members
- x. St. Francis Serves has had soft rollout, planning a hard rollout for the fall
 - 1. St. Francis Serves brought two families to the parish because they were able to see and sign up for all the varied ministries available
 - 2. Training plan will include communications committee and will investigate what other churches have had success with
