March 17, 2024 Fifth Sunday of Lent



A TRANSITION: As some of you know, my mother lives in New Bern, our family home since the early 60's. She will be 93 in June and is beginning to show significant signs of decline. With the death of my brother, his wife, and all five members of their immediate family in 2020, I am the only remaining family member residing in North Carolina. I have found it increasingly neces-

sary to be with my mother to handle more and more of her day-to-day life. We have discussed the idea of her moving to Raleigh to be closer to me, but this prospect is untenable for several reasons. Between the distance, the commute, and the growing need to be on site to help her while managing my responsibilities at St. Francis, I have come to the conclusion that it is incumbent upon me to make an adjustment to make her final years of life as comfortable as possible.

It is with heavy heart but also a sense of peace that I have decided, after 44 years of service to the Church as a priest, to take a slightly early retirement from full-time ministry this June when the normal transfers of clergy take place and will conclude my service to you as your pastor at St. Francis effective June 25.

Bishop Luís has chosen Fr. Chris Koehn, pastor of St. Mary Magdalene in Apex, as your new pastor. Fr. Chris is a very capable man, a proven effective leader, and a genuinely wonderful and joyful person. He also has a keen interest in Catholic education. His bio is below. You will learn more about him in the near future. His most important sentiment to me about coming is that he intends to "stay the course" in terms of our identity and mission. I have also been informed that a third priest will be assigned to our parish later this summer in response to our need for three priests in parish ministry here.

I want you to know that my greatest hesitations in this discernment process have been the potential impact of another leadership change so soon after the departure of the Franciscan friars and my true affection for you. As I have taken these concerns and others about our journey together and our plans for the near future to prayer, I have come to a sense of peace that all will be well, for you and for me, despite having to go through the process of change.

I will have further information to share with you in the coming weeks so stay tuned.

Chris had a full career as a project manager and took an early retirement from Chesapeake Hospitality before receiving a Master of Divinity degree from Pope St. John XXIII Seminary in Massachusetts. Since his ordination in 2018, he has served as parochial vicar at St. Thomas More Church in Chapel Hill and, since 2020, as administrator and pastor of St. Mary Magdalene, in Apex.
