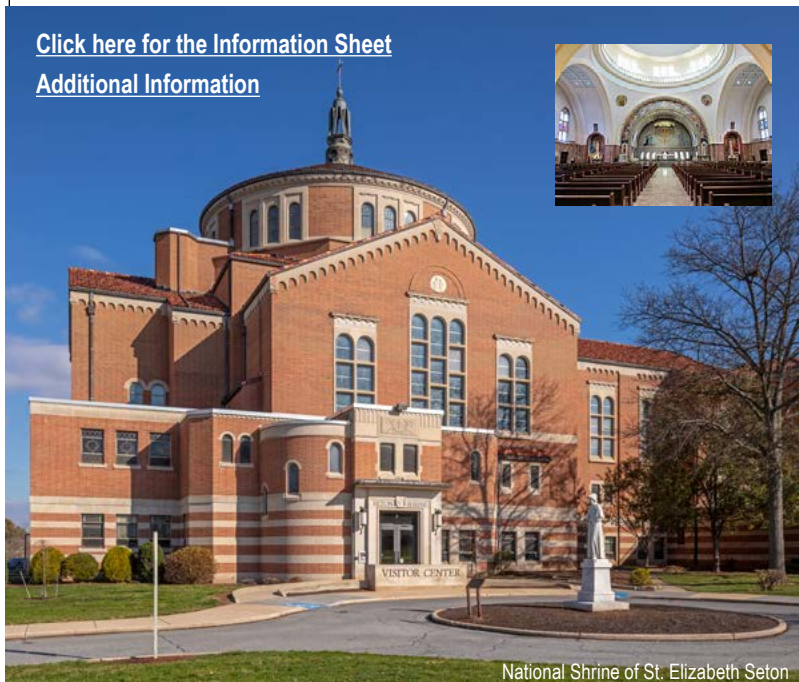



## Improving Society Through Our Faith

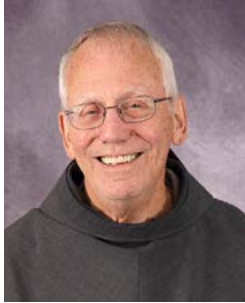

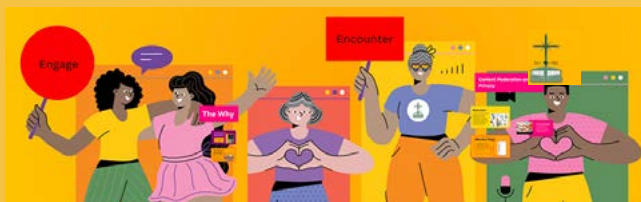
